Prerequisites for the Issue of the Certificates according to AQAP 2120 by BWB

The issue of the certificates (both initial and follow-up certificates) according to AQAP 2120 to German defense contractors by BWB (German Federal Office of Defense Technology and Procurement) Team T3.1 requires the following:

- at least one current design or production contract or subcontract with agreed GQA (Government Quality Assurance)
- a valid certificate according to ISO 9001 issued by an accredited certification body
- a contractor's request for (re)certification according to AQAP 2120
- successful performance of a quality management system audit related to the NATO Supplements to AQAP 2120

Initial Certification

Initial certification is carried out by BWB Team T3.1. The contract- and product-related review of the quality management system aims at ensuring that comparable efficient quality management systems of German defense contractors producing military products are applied.

Recertification

Recertification is carried out on the basis of the confirmation given by the competent GQA (Government Quality Assurance) office that the contractor's quality management system is being contract- and product-related applied effectively.

Validity of the Certificates according to AQAP 2120

The period of validity of the issued AQAP-certificates generally depends on the life of the corresponding ISO 9001 certificates.

The issued certificates according to AQAP 2120 will lose their validity if:

- the contractor's quality management system according to AQAP 2120 is not applied effectively/ not maintained any longer
- changes to the contractor's quality management system have adverse effects on the fulfillment of the NATO Supplements to AQAP 2120 and if these are not acceptable to the competent authority (BWB Team T3.1)
- changes referring to the organizational freedom of the management representative who, with sufficient staff technically and disciplinarily assigned to him, has to decide in matters pertaining to quality during contract execution, are not acceptable to the competent authority (BWB Team T3.1)

Remarks

- Changes to the contractor's quality management system with adverse effects on the fulfillment of the NATO Supplements to AQAP 2120 must always be submitted to the competent authority (BWB Team T3.1) for approval.
- Invalid AQAP certificates must be destroyed by the certificated company.
